

REINFORCED HEALTH PROTOCOL FOR THE 2022 FOOTGOLF FRENCH OPEN

FROM 23 TO 26 JUNE 2022 - GOLF PARC ROBERT HERSANT

This document sets out all the measures and precautions put in place by the team of the French FootGolf Association as part of the organization of the FootGolf French Open, at Golf Parc Robert Hersant, from Thursday 23 to Sunday June 26, 2021.

1- BEFORE THE EVENT

- The organizing team of the French FootGolf Association will inform registered players of the Reinforced Health Protocol to be strictly applied.
- Voluntary or repeated non-compliance with the Reinforced Sanitary Protocol may justify immediate exclusion of participants.
- The Reinforced Health Protocol will be sent by e-mail to all participants.
- A "COVID-19 Referent", will be appointed for this event. He must ensure that all the measures in force at the time of the event are well known to the participants.
- The game formula chosen for this competition is adapted to limit groupings of people within the golf course.
- Departures will be "tee time", which will facilitate the passage of participants throughout the course and around the Club House.
- Players will be informed of their start time and must arrive at hole n ° 1 maximum 15 minutes before their scheduled start time.

2- PLAYERS WELCOMING

- A regulation agent will be in charge of organizing parking for players upon arrival.
- A reception area will be organized outside, materialized by an open tent.
- Wearing a mask will be MANDATORY throughout the golf course, except during meals, where it will be compulsory to remain seated.
- A hydroalcoholic solution will be available in self-service at reception.
- A reminder of the sanitary rules will be posted at reception, as well as in several other places, notably on the terrace and around the Club House.
- When welcoming participants, a reminder of the health rules will be given to each player individually.



- Each player must report to reception INDIVIDUALLY in order to collect their welcome bag, including 1 protective mask.
- Masks will be available for sale at the boutique tent for registered players and accompanying persons.
- No grouping of more than 6 people should be made on and around the car park.
- Players will be expressly requested not to show up too early for the golf course, so as not to create a grouping within the golf course.
- Three security officers will be present near the club house in order to ensure that all the measures present in this reinforced health protocol are respected

3- RESTAURANT ORGANIZATION

- During the 4 days of the event, participants will have to eat in the golf course, primarily outdoors, and MUST be seated. Inside the Club House, wearing a mask is MANDATORY.
- The public reception level in the restaurant is set at 50% of the maximum capacity, or 82 people.
- No service will be done at the bar.
- During meals, apart from the service which will be in "buffet" configuration, participants must remain seated. Travel must be carried out with the wearing of a mask.
- Participants can take their order from the buffet in groups of 6 maximum.
- The catering staff will ensure that the buffet goes smoothly and limit the number of people standing simultaneously to a maximum of 6.
- Tables for a maximum of 6 people will be placed 2 meters apart from each other.
- A hydroalcoholic solution will be placed on each of the tables.
- The organizing team of the French FootGolf Association, as well as a security team will ensure compliance with these reinforced health measures.
- A3 format displays presenting all of the mandatory health measures will be placed in various places within the outdoor area as well as on the terrace

4- INSIDE THE CLUB HOUSE

- Apart from meals, the reception capacity within the Club House is 65% of the total reception capacity.
- No service will be carried out directly at the bar. Orders should be taken first from a table, seated.
- Within the Club House, players must MUST remain SITTED.
- In the event of consumption on site, and weather permitting, players will be seated on the terrace as a priority, within the limit of 6 people per table.
- A hydroalcoholic solution will be available at the bar.



5- ORGANISATION DES DÉPARTS

- Each squad (team of 4 or 5 players maximum) will present itself at the level of hole n ° 1 maximum 15 minutes before its scheduled departure time.
- Thus, there will never be more than 10 people at the same time in the immediate vicinity of the starting areas of the holes with the application of a minimum distance of 2 meters between each person.
- Departures will follow one another with an interval of 9 minutes.
- It is strongly recommended that players have a bottle of hydroalcoholic solution in their bag.

6- ON THE COURSE

- Players must arrive at hole 1 no more than 15 minutes before their scheduled departure time
- The players must respect a physical distance of 2 meters between them
- Players should not touch or manipulate flags and poles
- The ball must be taken out of the buggy only with the foot
- In case of raking, the players must wash their hands with a hydroalcoholic solution
- Mobile toilets will be available to players on the course (one toilet per course), in order to facilitate the passage to the toilets of the Club House
- Supplies will be made available to players at hole 1 of each course (water, fruit, cereal bars, etc.)

7- END OF PARTICIPATION

- At the end of their course, one participant per squad sends a complete scorecard to the organizing team, which performs the recording orally with the participant. Each player then places his score card on the scoring table, so that the organizing team can store it in the event of a subsequent dispute over the result, within the limit of 48 hours of storage.
- A hydroalcoholic solution will be available to participants at the scoring table.
- Security guards will ensure that no reunification takes place when participants return to the Club House. At the end of their course, participants must either leave the golf course or remain at the terrace and the Club House, but MUST BE SITTED



8- GOLF EXIT

 Each player will have been warned beforehand by the organizers that he must leave the golf course without creating a crowd of more than six people in the interior spaces and ten people in the car parks and always respecting the distance and the barrier gestures

9- AWARDS CEREMONY

An award ceremony will be organized according to the following recommendations:

- The prize-giving will take place primarily outside. Players must be seated, avoiding groups of more than 6 people indoors and 10 people outdoors.
- The microphone (s) used during the award ceremony must be individual or disinfected if the microphone changes hands.
- If, for weather reasons, the award ceremony must take place indoors, strict compliance with the sanitary measures in force will be applied. Players MUST be seated at the table within the limit of 6 per table.
- The event caterer must comply with the health rules established by the Government on the terrace, in an open ventilated tent or take-out.
